

**Amendment to the foundation charter of the “Association of European Cultural Institutes in Berlin”:**

**Revised form chapter 4, paragraphs b. and c.**

At the meeting of the Association of European Cultural Institutes in Berlin on the 28<sup>th</sup> of February 2005 the following revised forms of the paragraphs b. and c. of chapter 4 (Membership) given below were unanimously adopted:

**4. Membership**

a. (remains unmodified)

a. About the admission by written application of further European Cultural Institutes the association decrees by acclamation with a two-thirds majority in the absence of the applicant.

b. Partner-organisations with a cultural policy-background in Berlin can join the association by written application as associated members or as permanent guests. This is also effective for the cultural departments of the embassies of European countries, unless the country does not keep already an institute for culture. Associated members and permanent guests have no voting rights on the election of the executive committee. About their admission decides the community with a two-thirds majority in the absence of the applicant.

c. (remains unmodified)

After the signing of this document by the three sitting members of the executive committee it will be added to the original of the foundation charter (custody in the Finnland-Institut). The directions of all participating institutions receive a copy with the request to safeguard it together with the documents of the foundation charter.
